Old Business:

Gary Hart and Ben Deshotel built and installed a new replica of the gate on the Joseph Landry tomb that had been stolen several years ago. The cost was covered by a \$3,000 contribution to the Foundation for that purpose.

We received a generous contribution from Mark & Mike Landry of \$13,000.00 for the restoration in May 2021.

Nick Black agreed to restore the Landry Tomb for \$19,680

We have enough money to complete the tomb restoration, and currently have it scheduled with Nick Black.

It was agreed by all that after the Joseph Landry restoration is completed, we will consult with Nick Black to determine which other tombs could be restored with the money that is unused. Jim suggested that the tomb of the Landry Sisters be fixed. There is a large opening in the back of the tomb that needs to be closed up. Also, there are many tombs need to be cleaned of black mold.
